# Upcoming Events

## New Brunswick to experience a total solar eclipse.

On Monday April 8th we will have a once in a lifetime opportunity to witness a total Solar eclipse in New Brunswick. The central part of the province will be in the direct path of totality for the first time since the year 932! This means

we will experience complete darkness in the areas of Fredericton, Woodstock, Florenceville-Bristol and Miramichi. This will happen because the moon will slide completely in front of the sun blocking it's light for several minutes.

This event is expected to be an amazing phenomena to experience and something you will never forget. However we have to be prepared to keep our eyes safe during this event. The only time during the eclipse that you can safely view the eclipse without eye protection is during the few minutes of total darkness. Before and after totality the sun remaining around the edges of the moon will be extremely bright and can cause permanent eye damage. It is strongly advised that anyone planning to view this eclipse do so using special eclipse glasses, No.14 welding glass or specialized solar filters for use on telescopes and cameras. Many cities and communities have events planned for the entire weekend of April 6th—April 8th and have places you can pick up your own

eclipse glasses. The Florenceville-Bristol region will launch a balloon-borne solar telescope on a high-altitude balloon. This unique project is meant to provide live magnified telescopic images of the total eclipse taken from the stratosphere and broadcasted to audiences in a few locations in western New Brunswick and hopefully to the world via the internet. This will come in handy especially if we have a cloudy day as this telescope will be above the clouds. The SLO manages the Student Union office, Student communications, and is the Chief Returning Officer and much more.

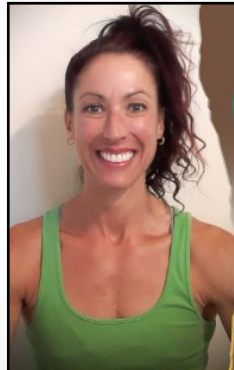
